5. Cancellation and Refund Policy

- Cancellation by Registrant: If registrant cancels their registration on or before April 3, 2026, they will receive a partial refund of the registration fee, minus a non-refundable processing fee of \$150.00 (Friday-only registration refund \$70; Saturday-only registration refund \$100; Sunday-only registration refund \$40). The organizer is not responsible for any additional costs incurred by the registrant (e.g., travel, accommodation, etc...).
- Cancellation after April 3, 2026: If the registrant cancels, no refund will be issued.
- Cancellation by Organizer: If the event is canceled by the organizer for any reason, including force majeure (acts of God, government restrictions, etc...), the registrant will receive a partial refund of the registration fee, minus a processing fee of \$50.00. The organizer is not responsible for any additional costs incurred by the registrant (e.g., travel, accommodation, etc.)

6. Transfer Policy

Registrations are non-transferable for any reason.

7. Code of Conduct

The registrant (and their companion) agrees to abide by the event's code of conduct, which includes respectful behavior toward all attendees, presenters/instructors, staff, and vendors. The organizer reserves the right to remove any registrant from the event for inappropriate behavior, without refund.

8. Event Changes

The event organizer reserves the right to make changes to the event program, including presenter/instructor changes, workshop/concert adjustments, and scheduling changes. The event organizer will make every effort to keep registrant notified of significant changes via the event website and/or social media.

9. Force Majeure

In the event of force majeure circumstances (e.g., natural disasters, government restrictions, pandemics, etc...), the event organizer may cancel, postpone, or change the format of the event. In such cases, the registrant will be notified, and the cancellation policy outlined above will apply.

10. Photography and Media Release

The registrant (and their companion) acknowledges that the event may be recorded or photographed. By attending, the registrant consents to the use of their likeness in event-related media, including photographs, videos, audio and other promotional materials, without compensation or further approval.

11. Liability Waiver

The registrant (and their companion) agrees to assume all risks associated with attending the event and releases the event organizer from any liability for injury, illness, loss, or damage that may arise from attending the event. The organizer will not be held responsible for any personal items lost, stolen, or damaged during the event.

12. Data Privacy

This agreement shall be governed by the laws of the state of Ohio, without regard to its conflict of law principles. Any disputes arising under this agreement shall be resolved through mediation or arbitration in Lucas County Court of Common Pleas.

14. Severability Clause

The invalidity or unenforceability of any provision of this Agreement shall not affect the validity or enforceability of any other provision of this Agreement, which shall remain in full force and effect.
